ACADEMIC GOAL #1

Engage students in high-quality instruction around Ohio's Learning Standards which includes research-based strategies that are rigorous in content and relevant to student needs.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Instructional practices will focus on the standards-based curriculum maps to ensure student achievement & progress.
2. Instruction will consist of the following criteria:
 - a. Learning targets/standards that are clearly defined and easily explained to students;
 - b. Collecting & documenting evidence of student learning (formative & summative evidence);
 - c. Analyzing evidence & providing effective feedback;
 - d. Evidence of student ownership in learning;
 - e. High-yield instructional practices will be evident in delivered instruction; and
 - f. The Canal Winchester Design Cycle will be displayed and used K-12.
3. All staff will develop at least two Project Based Learning activities that actively engage students in the design & implementation of the activity.
4. Develop positive relationships with students & parents.

ACADEMIC GOAL #2

Engage students in personalized learning using technology as an instructional tool to enhance, enrich, and engage them in the learning process.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Develop our students to be creators and not simply consumers of media.
 2. Create an environment in which technology enables students' self-direction & pacing.
 3. Design a flexible learning environment that allows students to work in a variety of ways: independently, in small groups & beyond the scheduled class time & space.
 4. Engage students in a variety of individualized & collaborative tasks.
 5. Staff will participate in professional development related to personalized learning.

Report Card



1. Increase achievement results by 2-3% in the majority of the subject areas and consistently earn an A or B.
 2. Increase Performance Index results by 2-3 points per year.
 3. Obtain positive points across all subgroups on Ohio's Annual Measurable Objectives (Gap Closing).
 4. Maintain a 4-year graduation rate at or above 93% as well as a 5-year graduation rate at or above 95%.
 5. Overall students will meet or exceed a year's worth of growth in all state progress categories:
 - a. Overall ELA & Math
 - b. Gifted
 - c. Students in the lowest 20%
 - d. Students with disabilities
 6. Strive to advance 100% of 3rd grade students under Ohio's Third Grade Reading Guarantee.
 7. ACT composite score will meet or exceed state average on an annual basis.
