

Canal Winchester Schools Required Health Documents

Immunizations

The vaccines required by the Canal Winchester Board of Education are the minimum requirements for students to comply with Ohio Law. Please provide immunization records verifying month, day, and year immunizations were given. These can be obtained from your healthcare provider or previous school. This information is to be provided to the school health staff by the student's 1st day of attendance. **As required by Ohio law, your child will not be permitted to continue attending school if the required immunizations are not complete and on file with the school health staff by the 14th day of school.**

Tuberculosis Test

New Students enrolling from foreign countries and students who are out of the country for 3 months must show written proof of results for a tuberculosis skin test given within the last 12 months.

Physical Examination

All **preschool, kindergarten** and **new first grade** students are required to have had a physical exam within the 12 months prior to beginning school. Kindergarten and first grade students are to have the school's Physical Exam Report form completed. Preschool students are to have the Medical Statement form completed. Ohio law requires that all **preschool** students must have a physical exam and Medical Statement completed every 13 months.

Parent OneView Health History and Student Information Forms - Keep updated!

The Health History form is only viewed by district school health staff. *This form also has the required documentation for your child to receive over-the-counter medication during school.*

The Student Information form is required by law. The school cannot release your child to anyone not listed as an emergency contact on this form. The Emergency Medical Authorization section provides vital health information to assist Emergency Medical Services in the event of an emergency.

Medication and Treatment Authorization

This form (available on the district website and in the school clinics) is *required by law* for your student to use any type of *prescription medication or prescribed treatments* while at school or any school-sponsored functions.

Activity Restriction Documentation

We ask that you provide documentation of any activity restrictions (i.e., stair climbing, physical education or recess restrictions) due to illness, injury, or surgery. A note from your child's healthcare provider is required if your child needs to use the **elevator, wheelchairs or crutches** during school.
